

TIPS FOR YOUR TRAVEL:



You are allowed to carry liquids in individual containers with a capacity of max 100ml. The liquids have to be carried in a transparent plastic bag which is re-sealable and not greater than 11 in capacity.



Photocopy of your passport – store it in different place than where you keep your passport so that you have identification if your original passport is lost or stolen.




Take a photo of your luggage, like your clothes and valuables so you have proof in case something goes missing.

FOR YOUR PERSONAL SAFETY:

Use TSA locks for securing your hand luggage as well as your carry-on luggage.





Place your under-seat bags with the zippers facing you to avoid the person sitting in front or behind from accessing the zipper. Store your bags face down to make it more difficult for someones else to open.

DO'S

- Lock your home windows, door, cellar, garden cabin...
- Lock your cars and bikes or park them inside.
- Inform your family or a trustworthy neighbor. Ask them to collect your mail.

DON'TS
